Have you ever wondered if are you being treated properly in your part time job, or what will happen if you get caught drinking before the age of 18?






LawEd conveys which law affects you and why. It will also tell you what happens if you break the law.






LawEd uses examples of real-life scenarios and cases to help young people understand the law.
